### TASTING NOTES

Aromas of ripe red berries and cherries and a little spice. The fruit is turning a bit darker in the mouth and features touches of licorice, herbs and spice. Nice smooth texture and good acidity. On the long, dry finish the spice turns a bit sweet with a touch of coffee underneath the lingering fruit.
