Showing very ripe cassis on the nose,
alongside savoury notes and smart oak.
There's splendid volume and richness, with a
core of ripe black fruit enlivened by exotic
spice, coffee and earthy depths.

FOOD PAIRING

Roasted and braised meats, game birds,
cheese.

POINTS OF DISTINCTION

Haut Faugères is the second wine – beautifully
presented – of Château Faugères, which has
benefited from major investment (the new
cellar, designed by Mario Botta, is
breathtaking) from parfumeur Silvio Denz. In
2012 Château Faugères was promoted from
Grand Cru to Grand Cru Classé, a subtle but
important change.
