TASTING NOTES

A beautiful deep, ruby hue with lots of almost confectioned cherry, blackcurrant and cranberries on the nose with a hint of liquorice. The palate has an explosion of brambly and hedgerow fruits with blueberries and cherries with excellent acidity and fine tannins.

FOOD PAIRING

This wine pairs well with grilled pork tenderloin, lamb and veal with fresh herbs.

POINTS OF DISTINCTION

In 1930, Gaston Hochar founded Chateau Musar, inspired by Lebanon's 6,000 year winemaking. His son, Serge Hochar who perfected the Musar formula, was chosen as Decanter Magazine's first 'Man of the Year' in 1984. Today the 3rd generation of the Hochar family are in charge.
