The wholly organic Clayvin Vineyard is one of the oldest and most prized vineyards in New Zealand. It has supplied grapes for a string of award-winning wines over the years and its Pinot Noir styles are frequently rated in the top 10 in New Zealand.

High density planting means Clayvin carries very low yields per vine, helping to produce wines of great concentration and richness.
