POINTS OF DISTINCTION

Marco Parusso is undoubtedly one of the most innovative Barolo producers in the whole of Piedmont. Often labelled a modernist, Parusso's unorthodox production methods have allowed him to achieve what very few winemakers have managed: a Barolo that is enjoyable in its youth, but also has a strong ageing potential.
