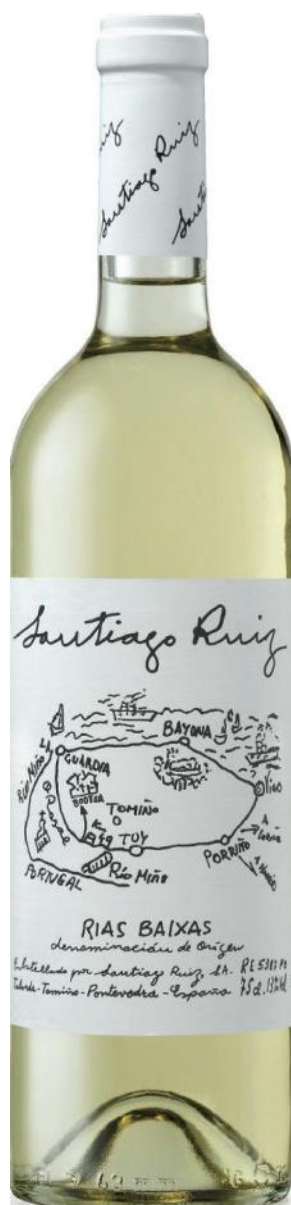

TASTING NOTES

Yellow straw colour with green reflections.
Clear and bright with an excellent appearance.
Very aromatic with fruity nuances (pear,
loquats, citrics) as well as balsamic (mint,
laurel) and mineral notes.
Powerful in the mouth, well-balanced in acidity
and with a long finish.

FOOD PAIRING

Ideal as an aperitif, this wine is the best
partner for fish and shellfish, as well as cold
starters.

POINTS OF DISTINCTION

Santiago Ruiz is often called "*the Father of Albarino*", as he has been the foremost
advocate of this beautiful grape variety all his
life. The label depicts the wedding map that
Santiago drew himself for his daughter's
wedding invitation.
