TASTING NOTES

The nose is rich, opening elegantly on notes of peaches and white blossom, mingling with citrus fragrances. On the palate, aromas of tropical fruits, lemon zest and spices reveal the full complexity of this wine. The wine possesses minerality with a hint of sustained acidity on the finish.

POINTS OF DISTINCTION

In 1308, the palace of the Pope was relocated to Avignon. The popes did promote local wines, more specifically the area 5–10 km north of Avignon. Under John XXII, the wines of this area came to be known as "Vin du Pape", this term later to become Châteauneuf-du-Pape.
