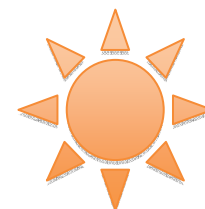
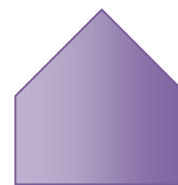


## NEVER MIND THE WEATHER – LET’S PLAY



### Catching Fish

**Location:** Indoors and Outdoors

**Age Range/skills required:** Any age can play

**Learning Objective:** Have fun with an activity which helps develop throwing and catching skills, counting skills and turn taking

**Curriculum area (s)** PE, PSHE, Maths

**Resources:** 2 Skipping ropes, 6 bean bags, 1 ball

#### Instructions:

- Split the teams into groups of 4.
- In each group of 4 the children choose a partner to form pairs.



- **To Play:**

The pairs sit opposite each other and you put 2 skipping ropes in between them to form the river. You then put about 6 beanbags in the river, these are the fish. The aim of the game is to collect as many fish as possible.

Children throw the ball to each other and catch it. If the ball lands in the river the other pair collects a fish. The game ends when all the fish have been collected. The winner is the pair with the most fish. You can make the game harder by widening the river or by introducing new ways of receiving the ball for example, to catch with one hand!
