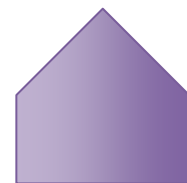


# NEVER MIND THE WEATHER – LET'S PLAY



## Dominoes

Making a set of dominoes and playing number matching game

**Location:** Classroom/Hall

**Age Range/skills required:** Number recognition and if making the dominoes scissor skills

**Learning Objective:** Have fun with a craft activity and number recognition and counting; if colouring in numbers: fine motor skills and turn taking

**Curriculum area (s) PSHE, Craft, Number recognition and can be played to improve number bond understanding**

**Resources:** Light coloured card or paper, laminator, paper trimmer, coloured pencils, if using finger holes a 1cm circular hole punch or circle cutter

### Instructions

- Make a set of dominoes out of coloured card from the template
- Make the dominoes size appropriate for the age of players
- If holes are to make the dominoes need to be larger
- Colour dots or numbers or make holes to represent numbers
- Laminate



### To Play

- Deal the dominoes (face down if using numbers)
- Double five starts
- Players take it in turns to add a domino if they have a number that matches one on the playing space
- The first one with no dominoes left is the winner
- The game can also be played where instead of matching numbers the numbers can also make 10
