Learning Objective: Have fun with a craft activity making cards, using fine motor skills and scissor skills then play games with the cards. The game supports visual perception, processing speed, hand to eye co-ordination and visual discrimination also turn taking and winning and losing

Resources: Coloured light card, scissors, pens, laminator

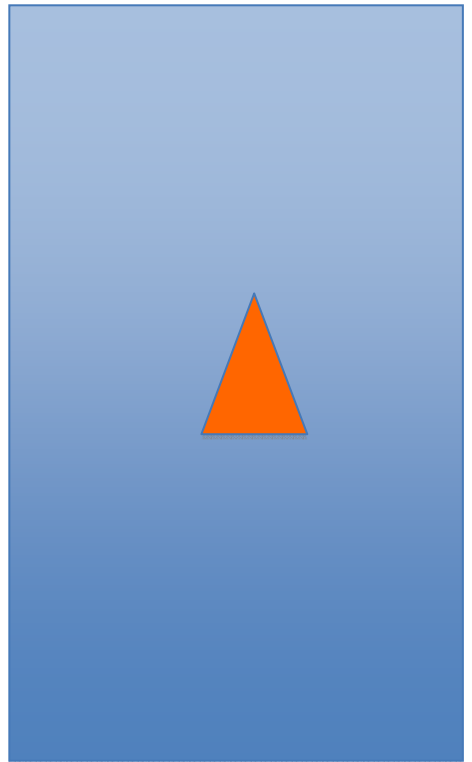
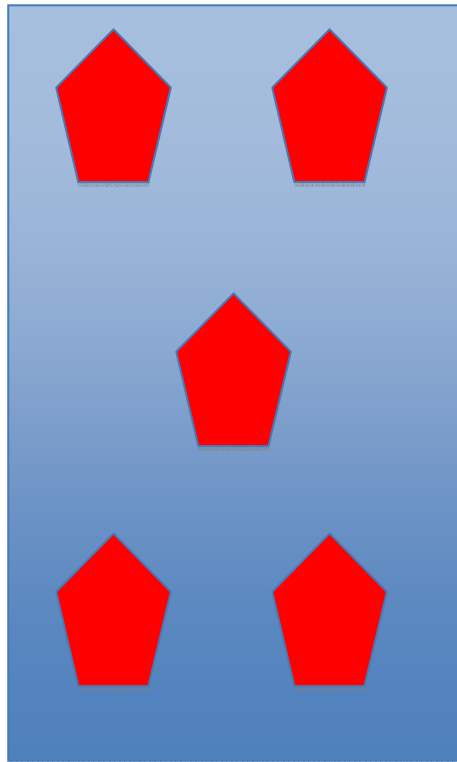
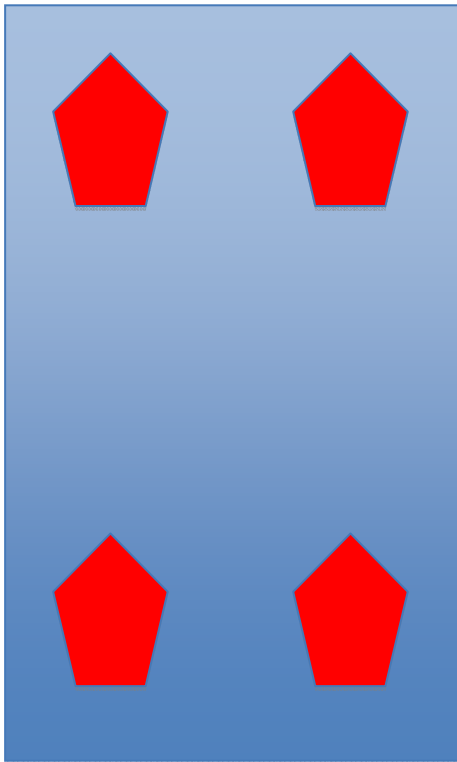
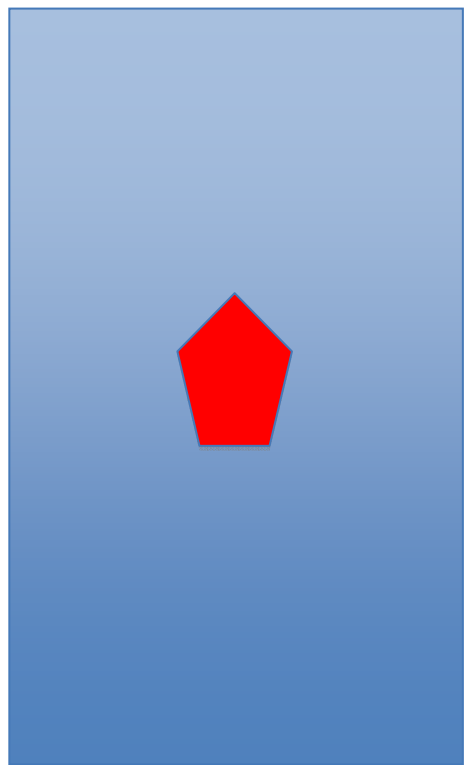
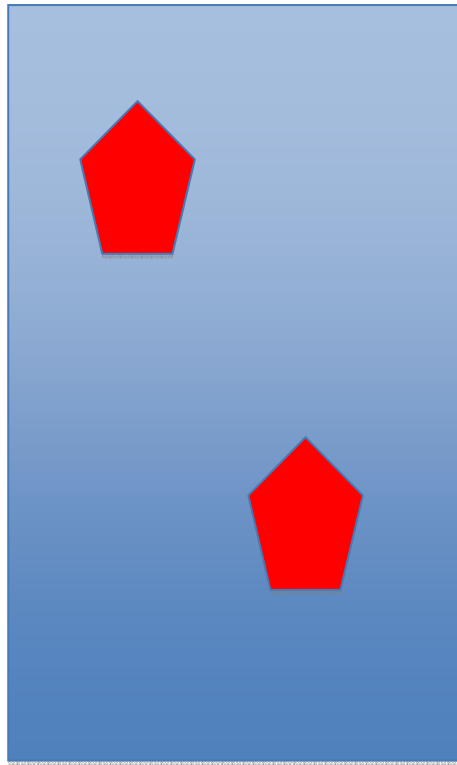
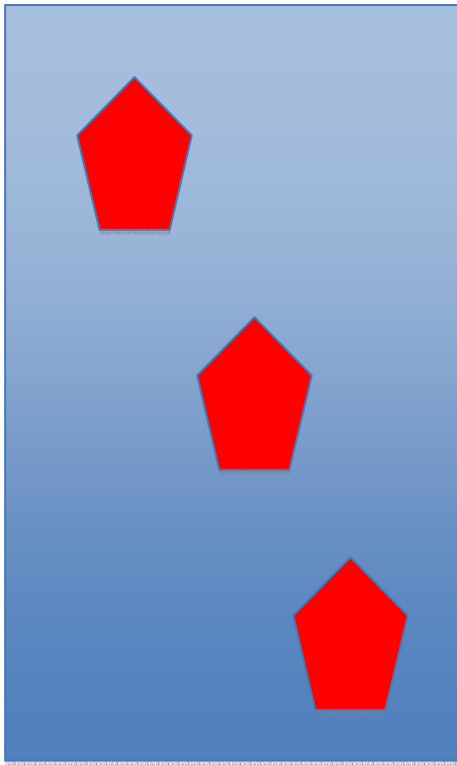
1. Photocopy template at 200%
2. Cut cards from templates onto light card
3. You will need each set in each of the 5 colours
4. Colour in shapes
5. Laminate cards



• To Play:

1. Deal out 5 or 10 cards to each player
1. Put the remaining cards face down on the table in a stack
2. Player 1 can put down any card, player 2 must then put down a card that matches in shape, colour or number
3. When a player cannot go they take a card from the stack
4. The winner is the player to have no cards left at the end

These cards could be adapted to have other shapes such as animals to colour in on them before playing and less cards and fewer shapes or colours will make the game easier



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
