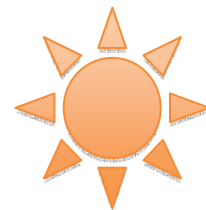
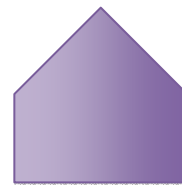


NEVER MIND THE WEATHER – LET’S PLAY



Snake Game

No language involved and children have to work in different and changing groups.

Location: Indoors and Outdoors

Age Range/skills required: Any age can play

Learning Objective: To have fun while developing self control and gross motor skills

Curriculum area (s) PE, PSHE

Instructions:

Divide children into groups of five.



- **To Play:**

Each group stands in a line, one behind the other and holds the waist of the person in front to form a snake.

The front player i.e. head of the snake, detaches and attempts to join the tail of another snake.

The snakes weave and dodge to prevent new members attaching themselves.

As soon as there is a new tail the head of that snake moves off to find another snake so that there are always only 5 in a group.
