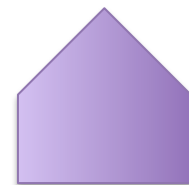


## NEVER MIND THE WEATHER – LET'S PLAY



### Where's the Bird?

A craft activity that also makes a game that supports visual perception

**Location:** Classroom

**Age Range/skills required:** Scissor skills/supports visual perception/Hand to eye co-ordination/Turn taking/scissor skills/winning and losing.

**Learning Objective:** Have fun with a craft activity and game using fine motor skills to make an imaginary bird out of card and then play a game with others

**Curriculum area (s)** Art/Craft, PSHE, Maths

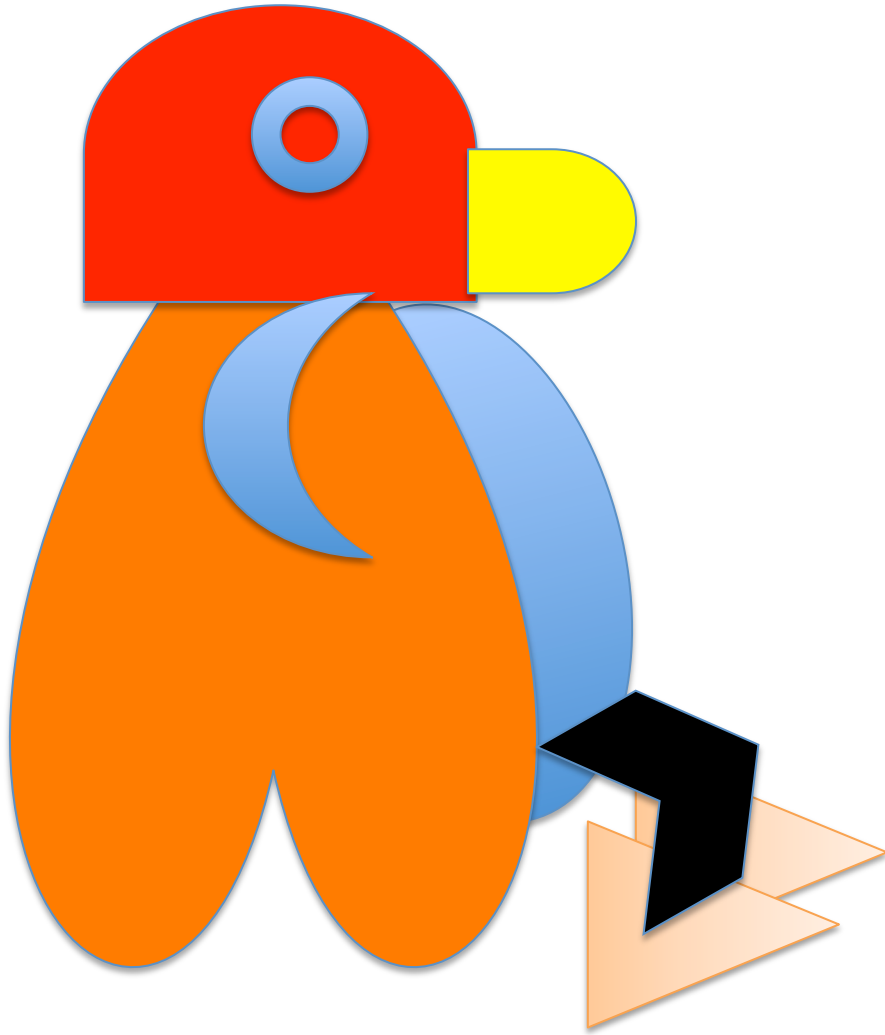
**Resources:** Coloured light card, scissors, felt tip pens and timer to play the game

### Instructions

1. Cut out shapes from templates onto light card, one set for each player
2. If using white card, colour in the shapes



- To Play:
- Each player has one set of shapes
- Set the timer for one minute (or appropriate time depending on age and ability of players)
- Can they make a bird by using all the shapes?
- What can they make?



One way of putting the shapes together to make an imaginary bird!
