**ORDER GRANTING THE GOVERNMENT’S MOTION TO VACATE
DEFENDANT’S CONVICTION AND DISMISS THE INDICTMENT
IN DOCKET 10-CR-127-F**

This matter is currently before the Court on the motion entitled “Government’s Concession to Defendant’s 28 U.S.C. § 2255 Motion and Motion to Vacate Defendant’s Conviction and Dismiss the Indictment.” In this motion the government asks the court to grant the Defendant’s habeas motion filed in civil case 12-CV-105-F, requests that the Defendant’s conviction in criminal case 10-CR-127-F be vacated, and asks for permission to dismiss the indictment in case 10-CR-127-F.

Having reviewed the motion, the file, and otherwise being fully informed in the premises, the Court hereby **GRANTS** the government’s motion.


IT IS ORDERED THAT the Defendant’s 28 U.S.C. § 2255 motion, filed in civil case 12-CV-105-F, shall be and hereby is granted in the interests of justice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Defendant’s conviction and sentence in criminal

case 10-CR-127-F is hereby **VACATED** and the Defendant **SHALL BE AND HEREBY IS ORDERED RELEASED** from any confinement relating to that conviction.

The United States is granted permission, in accord with Rule 48 of the Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure, to dismiss the indictment against the Defendant in criminal case 10-CR-127-F.
